Notes:

- (1) Seminars, clinics, and other classes with no final exams are not listed on this schedule.

- (3) Take-home exams that are due on the scheduled date above are marked with an asterisk. Students should confirm with their instructor the exact time when the exam must be submitted to eCampus.
- (4) Take-home exams that are "self-scheduled" are not listed on this exam schedule. An exam is "self-scheduled" if the student may choose when to turn in the exam OR the exam has a fixed due date, but the student has a week or more to complete the exam. Self-scheduled take-home exams do NOT count for purposes of the "three exams in three days" rule. A list of classes with self-scheduled take-home exams is included below.
- (5) Most exams are assigned multiple rooms if faculty wish to use them, but whether to use more than one room is up to the faculty instructor.
