A law graduate may be hooded by a WVU College of Law graduate or member of the Bar of any State who is the parent, spouse, sibling, grandparent, aunt, uncle or domestic partner* of the graduate.

* Domestic partner: a long term domestic relationship such as those recognized for the purpose of medical benefits, health insurance and medical decision making.

If there is an eligible person in your immediate family who would like to take part in the ceremony, please fill out the form below and return it to **Katherine M. Slavic, Room 234-C** (next to the Law Review office).

Although special seating will be reserved for the person taking part in the hooding, they should be at the Creative Arts Center no later than 1:30 p.m. in order to be appropriately seated near the stage.

Family members/alums who will be taking part in the Hooding Ceremony will be seated next to the stage and will walk up the stairs to the stage when the graduate reaches the Student Marshal. The family member/alum will walk with their graduate to center stage where the graduate will hand the hood to the Dean who will then hand the hood to the family member. The family member/alum stands **behind** the graduate, places the hood over the graduates' head and **pauses for a picture**. The graduate turns and shake hands with the Dean. The graduate proceeds to his/her seat and the family member/alum returns to their reserved seat in the audience.

There will **not** be room in the reserved area for families to sit with the person doing the hooding; but if they arrive early, they may be able to find nearby seats.
