BUT NOW...VOILA! THE UBE!

- The score on a Uniform Bar Examination (UBE) is portable to participating jurisdictions. It is a portable score NOT a portable status. 35 jurisdictions currently participate!
- If you take the UBE in West Virginia, your score can be transferred to other UBE jurisdictions. Furthermore, a non-passing score in West Virginia might be passing score in another UBE state.
- The UBE passing score in West Virginia is 270.
- To practice in another UBE state, you will still need character and fitness certification. Also, there may be other requirements, such as an online quiz for state-specific laws, or additional testing.
